

KILCHOMAN DISTILLERY



Kilchoman Distillery was founded in 2005 and is the first distillery to be built on Islay for over 120 years. Kilchoman displays all that is great about the grass-roots traditions of Scotch whisky distilling. As well as being one of only a handful of distilleries still practicing floor malting, barley is also grown on the farm, making Kilchoman the only distillery to complete all parts of the whisky making process on site. Kilchoman truly is Islay's farm distillery – from barley to bottling.

"Farm distilling has become common in American craft whiskey, but the concept — though ancient in practice — is still relatively unknown in Scotch. The modern industry largely sources grain through commercial suppliers, both because it's cheaper and because growing barley in Scotland's fickle climate is a gamble. Kilchoman, an independent distillery opened in 2005 on Islay, was willing to take that gamble, farming 2,300 acres every year for this expression. It's the only whisky that is 100 percent produced on the island, from planting the seeds to malting the barley over local peat to bottling the final product. The effort and expense are considerable, but they yield a whisky that's chock-full of character and provenance. A handful of other Scotch distilleries farm their own barley, including Lochlea, Arbikie, and Daftmill. Provenance and local sourcing are increasingly important within Scotland's whisky industry. But Kilchoman remains the only producer to do everything — seed to sip — in one location, proof that it's possible, even if it's not easy."

Our 100% Islay range is the world's only Single Farm Single Malt Scotch Whisky.

It represents the revival of traditional farm distilling; growing our own barley before malting, distilling, maturing and bottling every bottle of our 100% Islay range on site. The 100% Islay 14th Edition was distilled from our 2013 and 2014 barley harvests before being matured in selected bourbon and oloroso sherry casks for a minimum of 9 years.

'Machir Bay' Single Malt

Machir Bay, our signature peated single malt, is a vatting of Kilchoman matured in both bourbon and sherry casks. Named after Islay's most spectacular beach, the high proportion of bourbon barrels create a distinct balance of classic Islay character and fresh floral complexity.

Nose: Soft cooked fruits with strong peaty aromas.

Palate: Soft mixed fruits and vanilla with an intense sweetness.

Finish: A Classic Islay malt now showing the benefit of additional ageing. A long lingering finish.

Loch Gorm 10-Year 2025 Release

Loch Gorm is the name given to our annual sherry matured limited edition. Named after Islay's largest freshwater loch neighboring the distillery, the dark murky color of the loch's water is reflected in the rich coppery tones of our sherry matured Loch Gorm release. Loch Gorm is exclusively matured in oloroso sherry casks from the renowned bodega, Jose Miguel Martin. It is common for distilleries to use a variety of sherry producers but for our consistent quality and character, it is vital that we source them all from just one bodega. We select a combination of sherry butts and hogsheads from Jose Miguel Martin that provides two separate styles of maturation. These ex-oloroso sherry casks impart a combination of heavy sherry notes, spicy dark chocolate, rich fruits and burnt sugar. This balances beautifully with the Kilchoman peat smoke and citrus fruits found within our farm crafted spirit.

13-Year Limited Edition

This limited release has been matured for 13 years in a combination of bourbon barrels, octaves and calvados casks. The whisky exudes an abundance of juicy fresh fruits, intense sweetness and waves of Islay maritime peat smoke.
