Established in 2008, LOLA's passion for creating naturally elegant, high quality, and honestly-priced wine stems from our vision of making great wine that can be enjoyed by all. Seth Cripe was a wine prodigy at a very early age, telling his mom he knew he was going to be a winemaker someday. By age 14, she was taking him from their home in Florida to work harvests in Napa Valley at Swanson Vineyards and after a few years he caught the attention of Charlie Wagner and was soon in charge of the Belle Glos Pinot Noir project and traveling to France 3-4 months a year. While working for Caymus, he fell in love with Burgundy. "I was very fortunate to spend a lot of time in Europe, so I have a preference for wines that are more delicate. I wanted to make wines in an elegant, old-world style that is authentic and unpretentious." After twelve years at Caymus, he did just that and launched LOLA, named after his beloved fluffy grey dog rescued in the mountains above the California coast.





2022 Lola Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast

The 2022 LOLA Sonoma Coast Chardonnay is pale gold in color with flavors of tropical fruit and citrus, complimented by delicate floral aromas and a bright, crisp mouthfeel. A portion of this wine is aged in older oak going through a secondary malolactic fermentation, in an effort provide a caramelized richness to the aromatics and finish.

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2022 Lola Rosé of Pinot Noir, California

100% Pinot Noir grapes grown on our younger vines in Mendocino and Sonoma Coast. The grapes were picked slightly under-ripe and lightly crushed by foot, then pressed off the skins after 8 hours. We do add a small amount of skins and stems to the press juice during fermentation which adds a bit more vibrancy and structure to the finished wine. 100% stainless steel. Vibrant, with a bright pink color and aromas of cherry and guava. Its bright acidity and crispness on the palate make it a perfect wine for warm summer days, and a wonderful pairing to vegetables and seafood.

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2021 Lola Pinot Noir, California

LOLA California Pinot Noir is a blend of unique vineyards from Mendocino, Russian River Valley, Sonoma Coast and Monterey. 3 day cold soak. 10% whole cluster for 11 days at 82 degrees. 100% French (20% 2nd year) for 6 months.

2021 Lola Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley

Our Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is a blend of Dijon clones 115, 777, as well as a suitcase clone from Vosne Romaneé, France, brought back by our winemaker in 2005; all of which are planted at our Bloomfield Road Vineyard in the Russian River Valley AVA. This wine is deep garnet in color with aromas of wild strawberry, cherry, red currants and forest floor, accented by notes of dried tea, rose petals, cedar and vanilla bean. On the palate, the wine's bright acidity and supple texture are accompanied by delicate tannins and a long, lingering finish.

2021 Lola Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley

Lola Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is grown on the valley floor just south of the town of St Helena and a bit north of Rutherford. The wine has all of the characteristics of classic Napa Valley Cabernet with powerful blackberry and black cherry aromas combined with cacao, tobacco and toasted oak. On the palate the wine is delicate and smooth yet uniquely fresh and bright. This wine is tasting beautifully upon release but will continue to evolve and be a joy to drink over the next 5-10 years. 100% de-stemmed and fermented on skins for 14 days at 78 degrees. Fermented in open top tanks with hand punch downs. 100% French Oak for 8 months (70% 2nd year 30% 3rd year).

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
