Known For: Taking countermeasures to save vineyards in danger of being abandoned and bringing these vineyard owners into the cooperative. All vineyards in Vienna by law must be cultivated which protects the land from real estate development. The history of the winery goes back as far as 1683. In 1817, Ludwig van Beethoven resided in the romantic house (now the winery) which is protected as a historic monument. During his time there, he worked on his 9th symphony.

The vineyards are situated entirely within the city boundaries of Vienna, in the 17th and 19th districts. Vienna is the only metropolitan city in the world with notable viticultural areas within its city boundaries and its terroir is unique.



Countless awards and prizes at national and international wine competitions emphasize the high quality of the wines from the House of Mayer am Pfarrplatz.



2024 Landhaus Mayer Riesling

100% Riesling from selected vineyards in the Weinviertel. Loess and clay soil. Hand-harvested. Fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks.

Intense floral aromas of lilac with delicate apricot notes. Complex fruit extract with honey aromas and balanced, juicy extract with vibrant acidity and a nice, mineral finish. With floral fruity aromas, medium-bodied, very lively and refreshing, perfect as aperitif and for lunch



2023 Landhaus Mayer Grüner Veltliner

100% Grüner Veltliner from selected vineyards in the Weinviertel. Loess and clay soil. Hand-harvested. Fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks. Peppery notes mingle with clear grapefruit aromas; the body is well-balanced, offering a pleasant acidity and delicate herbal spiciness; lively on the finish. With elegant spicy aromas, this medium-bodied wine, which is very lively and refreshing, is the perfect food partner. A classic, quaffable Gruner.

2024 Landhaus Mayer Rosé

Zweigelt and Pinot Noir from selected vineyards in Carnuntum. Loess and clay soil. Hand-harvested. Fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks. This Rosé is characterized by an intense salmon pink color and a subtle strawberry and cassis aroma. It has a spicy and vibrant finish.



2022 Landhaus Mayer Zweigelt

100% Zweigelt from selected Vineyards in Carnuntum. Fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks. 8-10-year-old vines. Medium-bodied and very juicy, with an intense cherry aroma.
