



CHATEAU BOURGNEUF

Our first partnership in Bordeaux, came at the encouragement of our longtime friend, Marie Vayron- Ponsonnet, when she introduced us to her family's vineyard, Château Bourgneuf, in Pomerol - a prestigious appellation spread over 9 hectares in one unique holding. Today, her father, Xavier, her mother, Dominique and sister, Frédérique Vayron, continue to oversee the winery. Bourgneuf has belonged to the Vayron family since 1840. Eight generations have succeeded each other, transmitting their love for this land and its history. Since 2008, Frédérique Vayron has worked at Chateau Bourgneuf as the viticulture and winemaking specialist.



Saisons de Bourgneuf 2023

95% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc. A cuvée created by Frédérique in 2012 and made entirely from a vineyard planted in 2010. Instead of blending it into the main cuvee of Pomerol, she aims to make a cuvée that was true to its place but also showcase Merlot in a more early drinking style. Fermentation takes place in temperature controlled cement vats and the wine is aged in oak barrels for 12 to 14 months.
