The remains of a stone castle is testament to the wealthy past of this important Lordship whose origins date back to the Middle Ages, and where vines have continued to flourish over the centuries. For connoisseurs and amateurs alike, Bordeaux often calls to mind the world of Grand Cru Classé wines, the true elite of Bordeaux, if not the world, an unrivalled icon in fine wine circles. Yet Bordeaux is also about smaller, less well-known appellations, which certainly influenced Dourthe's decision to purchase Château Pey La Tour in 1990, fully committed to revealing the full potential of this stunning terroir and craft a magnificent, characterful, complex and elegant wine. Investment in the vineyard and winery alike have elevated Château Pey La Tour to the very summit of the appellation, imparting the wine with fruit-laden, rounded character and complexity to rival the region's greatest names. The wines at Château Pey La Tour are geological jewels. They benefit from a remarkable diversity of soils that are unique to the region, and span 90 parcels. Soil studies carried out on each parcel identify the most suitable plant matter for each soil-type. Vinified and matured in separate batches, the parcels offer Château Pey La Tour the character and complexity typical of a Bordeaux fine wine.

85% Merlot
12% Cabernet Sauvignon

Lovely bright ruby in color, with brooding reflections. Highly expressive on the nose, offering delicious tangy fruit notes of wild blackberries and raspberries. Fresh from the outset, the wine develops crunchy, juicy fruit character, underpinned by silky tannins. Pey La Tour 2020 is beautifully balanced and culminates in a long, fresh and flavorsome finish.
