

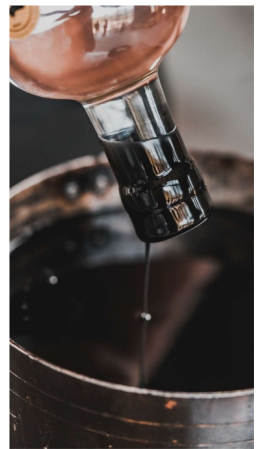
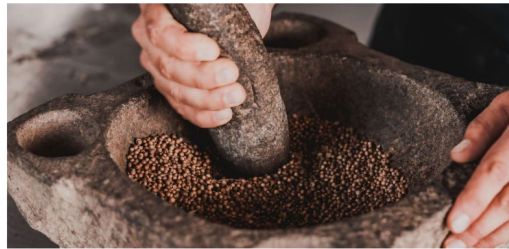


GIN PROVINCIA

The most awarded Chilean Gin

In 2017 master distiller and co-founder, Gustavo Carvallo had the idea to create Gin Provincia. It all happened after an English friend, surprised by the landscape, flora and botany of the Colchagua Valley, gave him the idea of distilling gin locally. The cultural and botanical rescue of Chile is the purpose behind our work as a distillery, but it's our love of gin that brought us together as partners. A long but entertaining story that culminates with a distillate that encapsulates the essence of our country.

The Alto Colchagua distillery, located at the foot of the Andes in the Colchagua region, produces gin in small copper stills, ensuring extreme care in the distillation temperature and the delicate treatment of each of its ingredients. Within the O'Higgins region lies the Colchagua Valley, an area world-renowned for its excellent wines and rural culture. Our distillery is located in the town of Puente Negro, San Fernando, surrounded by spectacular native flora and fauna. This area lies at the foot of the Universidad Glacier, where the purity of our waters and botanicals originate. The mountainous area boasts a unique botanical wealth, with more than 20 endemic botanicals, where pristine waters flow from eternal glaciers and cascade down the mountain slopes, providing freshness and purity, synonymous with our identity and our constant pursuit of the highest quality.

Our purpose is the cultural and botanical recovery of Chile, which is why our botanicals are selected one by one to ensure they faithfully represent the region in which they were collected. The magic begins when the arrieros, our sustainably managed mountain harvesters, descend from the Andes Mountains with herbs and fruits that inspire the base of our gin. We are beginning a reforestation project in which we aim to help rescue and restore the native species of the Colchagua Valley. At our distillery, we aim to create a positive impact on the environment, thereby ensuring a better future for our ecosystem.
