

La Resistance

The name *The Resistance* has to do with the organic farming and the process they developed when the grapes are brought into the winery. Since the wine is Sans Soufre (made without sulphur additions) they cover the grapes with yeast to help them resist bacterial contamination of any kind. This also has the added benefit of raising the aromatic fruit profile of the wine. An incredible value with so much thought and work behind it.

Fun Fact: Floréal is a white grape variety created by the French National Institute for Agricultural Research. It was developed to keep most of the good qualities of Vitis vinifera grapes, while introducing diseaseresistance genes so that vineyards need fewer chemical treatments. **Certified Organic, Vegan!**

Varietals: 100% Floreal

Vineyard Location: Southern Rhone Valley

Type of Soil: clay soil with pebbles and stony terraces

Elegant aromas of pink grapefruit and white flowers with hints of exotic fruit. The palate combines all the freshness of citrus with the finesse of floral flavors.



2024 CDR Rouge Sans Soufre

Varietals: 60% Syrah 40% Grenache.

<u>Vineyard Location:</u> Plot selection and blend from selected pre-Alpes Villages (Nyons, Richerenches, Sérignan), altitude vineyards in terraces with a cooler climate. Altitude between 300 to 500m

Type of Soil: clay soil with pebbles and stony terraces

Rich dark cherry and blackberry framed by a spicy herbal thread and smooth tannins, finishing with a mineral-tinged linger.
