Nestled in Scansano, the heart of Maremma, lies the Terenzi winery. Just a stone’s throw from the famed Terme di Saturnia hot springs and the Argentario coast, it’s also within easy reach of Florence and Rome (a two-hour drive). This is a new side of Tuscany, authentic and untouched. Imagine charming villages bursting with art, pristine beaches lapping at the (some of Italy’s cleanest) shores, and a vibrant landscape that shimmers with wild beauty. Lush vineyards carpet rolling hills that soften towards the sea, while rows of cypress trees and coastal pines mingle with olive groves. Here, in this southernmost corner of Tuscany, Terenzi calls home. They meticulously manage five distinct vineyards, each with its unique character. From this blessed land, they craft singular and captivating wines that are a true expression of this hidden gem.



Spanning 150 hectares, Terenzi boasts 60 hectares of vineyards and 14 hectares of ancient olive groves. Founded in 2001 by the Terenzi family, they’ve become a cornerstone of Maremma’s thriving wine region. Their passion for showcasing this underappreciated terroir is evident in their beautifully crafted wines. Terenzi’s commitment to quality extends beyond the bottle. Their 3,000-square-meter winery completed in 2004 offers an immersive wine tourism experience. In 2012, Gambero Rosso recognized Terenzi as an Emerging Winery, solidifying their reputation for innovation. Terenzi is renowned for its range of elegant, contemporary wines. Their acclaimed Vermentino Balbinus, the dessert wine Passito Petit Manseng, and the Sangiovese powerhouse Madrechiesa (awarded Tre Bicchieri 11 times) are just a few examples of their dedication to excellence.

Our entire production process is autonomous. The management of our own vineyards, the harvest of the grapes, wine making and bottling are all made with passion and care by a highly specialized and motivated staff led by Giuseppe Caviola, one of the most important winemakers in Italy and in the world.



2022 Morellino di Scansano

The farm’s inaugural wine, our Morellino stands out for its drinkability, freshness, and elegance. With an intense ruby-red hue, it’s exclusively aged in steel, boasting a clean aromatic profile highlighted by lively notes of red fruits and spices.

100% Sangiovese. De-stemming and partial rupturing of the grapes. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature. Malolactic Carried out spontaneously, in stainless steel tanks. Aged in stainless steel.



2020 Morellino di Scansano Riserva Madrechiesa

Madrechiesa is the symbolic wine of the winemaking history of Casa Terenzi, a Tuscan winery created by a family who had the privilege of choosing to belong to the wonderful land of Maremma. Madrechiesa represents the selection of a single vineyard, the maximum expression of the Sangiovese grape. In this wine we can find the essence of the Tuscan territory's vocation for great red wines, together with the entrepreneurial spirit of the Balbino brothers, Federico and Francesca Romana Terenzi.

Fermentation in temperature-controlled stainless steel for 15 days. Aged 12 months in barrel and another 6 months in bottle. Offers inviting aromas of dark fruit, violets, and spices. This wine has smooth, generous tannins and a juicy finish.

91 Points - Wine Enthusiast - *“On the nose, wild cherry overtones sparkle above savory, anchoring aromas of hot tar, pepper, sun-dried tomatoes and herbs. Strawberries accentuate that cherry note on the palate, even as soil and more herbs provide balance. Tannins are smooth and flexible.”*



2021 Morellino di Scansano Riserva Purosangre

This pure Sangiovese boasts an intense ruby robe, echoing the strength, vibrancy, and elegance of the "morelli" - the Maremma horses that inspired the name Morellino. Aged for 12 months in large barrels followed by 6 months in bottle, it unfolds in the glass with captivating aromas of ripe red fruit and warm spices. The tannins are dense yet smooth, leading to a lingering and polished finish.



2018 Francesca Romana

Francesca Romana is a masterful blend of Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Merlot, showcasing these three international grape varieties in an exemplary way. The winemaking skill shines through in the precise extraction, resulting in expressive elegance and aromatic focus. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature for 15 days. Malolactic fermentation carried out spontaneously, in stainless steel tanks. 18 months in French oak barrels. 6 months in bottle.

2022 Balbinus Vermentino di Maremma

Balbinus pays a passionate tribute to Vermentino, championing its enduring appeal and expressive character. From carefully chosen plots rich in limestone, including the oldest vines, it matures in ceramic and steel. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature, without the skins. With enticing aromas of sage and white peach, it offers a refreshing, juicy sip and a satisfying, lingering finish.
