-Sustainable, Mostly Organic -

Kings County Distillery is New York City's oldest, largest, and premier whiskey distillery, the first since prohibition. Kings County makes handmade moonshine, bourbon, and other whiskeys out of the 119-year old Paymaster Building in the Brooklyn Navy Yard. We use New York grain and traditional distilling equipment to make distinctive spirits. Kings County's whiskeys are mashed, fermented, distilled, and aged onsite in Brooklyn and **never sourced from other producers.**

With traditional copper whiskey stills made in Scotland, wooden fermenters were built locally by Isseks Brothers, and a corn and barley patch at a small farm onsite, the distillery is a model of sustainable and traditional whiskey production and one of the preeminent craft distilleries in the United States, having been named Distillery of the Year in 2016 from the American Distilling Institute and have been praised by the New York Times, Wine & Spirits Magazine, GQ, The New Yorker, and many others. Provisions is honored to represent one of the most respected craft distillers in America.



Straight Bourbon

Made from New York State organic corn and malted barley from the U.K. Twice distilled in copper pot stills and then aged in new charred oak barrels. It is characterized by a rich aroma of fresh corn, balanced with the sweet caramelized oak sap from small barrels. It has a very strong sweet base with flavors of vanilla and caramel, a deep molasses taste to the middle notes, and leaves a smooth finish with hints of cinnamon and autumn spices. Aged for at least two years, this bourbon is a precocious whiskey, surprisingly robust for its age. **Organic!**

Barrel Strength Bourbon

Clocking in at 126-133 proof depending on the batch, Kings County Barrel Strength Bourbon is blended from older barrels than our flagship bourbon, aged anywhere from four to seven years. Many enthusiasts prefer whiskey undiluted from the barrel, as it offers a more intense concentration of flavor. Bold and complex, this is our most consistently acclaimed limited-release offering.

Peated Bourbon

'The 12 Best New Bourbons' -VinePair 2021

What is Peated Bourbon? It's bourbon whiskey that conforms to the American requirements for bourbon but is made with malted barley that has been exposed to peat smoke, a practice more common in Scotch whiskies—the malt we use for the peated bourbon was even grown and kilned in Scotland. So it's a hybrid whiskey of the two traditions, flavorful and robust from having aged in a new barrel, with an added light smoky finish reminiscent of single-malt. If scotch and bourbon had a baby, this is what it would taste like. As far as we can tell, ours was the world's first ever peated bourbon and will appeal to the adventurous whiskey traveler who has tried everything.

Empire Straight Rye Whiskey

Our Straight Empire Rye is made with 80% Danko rye grown in Ancramdale, New York, and 20% English malted barley. It's double pot distilled and aged in charred oak barrels for a minimum of three years. It is one of the few commercially available rye whiskeys made grain-to-glass in the Northeast, where rye first originated in this country. It is also part of a broader project with like-minded distillers throughout New York State to create a rye whiskey category derived from New York's whiskey heritage. Empire Rye must be made from at least 75% New York-grown rye, must be distilled in New York, and meet the standards for straight rye whiskey. Empire Rye has been on the market for a while, but only now do we have an always-available signature release that lives up to the rich history of whiskey in the Northeast.

With no corn in this mashbill, this high-rye recipe offers notes of honeycomb, orange zest, and cinnamon on the nose while toffee brittle, dried apricot, and barrel spice overtake the palate, and a lingering finish of maple, anisette, and marzipan.



Empire Rye Whiskey Barrel Strength

After evaluating our inventory of Empire Rye in preparation for this year's annual blend, the blending team determined that the bulk of our Rye inventory had matured — and concentrated — in ways that resembled many of our best cask-strength bourbon offerings. As so, beginning with this eighth batch of our Empire Rye — our first with a three-year age statement — our annual releases will be bottled at barrel strength (60.5% ABV). This year's batch emphasizes the complexities also gained through lengthier small-format barrel maturation. Featuring a diverse split of 10-, 15-, and 53-gallon barrels between the ages of 3 and 6 years old, Barrel Strength Empire Rye Batch #8 opens with a nose of rum-soaked raisin, structured oak, maple, vanilla, and cinnamon. The rich and layered palate features further familiar dark-fruit notes of fig and date cake, while an array of baking spices — black pepper, most notably — elegantly balance the sweetness through the finish. With a small addition of water, notes of clove, allspice, and pomegranate become prominent.

Coffee Whiskey



Coffee Whiskey is made in close collaboration with longtime Brooklyn Navy Yard neighbors Parlor Coffee. Obsessively crafted from a blend of Kings County's finest whiskeys and Parlor's exceptional ready-to-drink Cold Brew, our Coffee Whiskey sets out to define a more elegant and thoughtful flavored spirit. With a balance, complexity, and depth of flavor that is as suited for cocktail backbars as it is late-night neat pours, this hyper-local whiskey aims to represent the forefront of Brooklyn's craft culture to the wider world. While cocktail-making has evolved rapidly over the last two decades, spirits companies haven't necessarily kept up with the times. Coffee, in the context of cocktails, often means one of two things: either syrupy coffee liqueurs, or the use of coffee itself as a component ingredient. Our blending team imagined Coffee Whiskey as a newer, better expression of those concepts. 14mg of caffeine per 1.5oz serving

The lively, tropical top notes and creamy, chocolate undertones of Parlor's Cold Brew marry perfectly with the balanced sweetness and rich complexity of our own blend of house-made bourbon and corn whiskey. The resulting drinking experience is that of a true whiskey, but with an added depth of flavor that evokes the elegance of fine Madeira wines and Italian amari.
