Our Kuranui label depicts the journey of this outstanding Sauvignon Blanc from grapes to wine. Named after the Maori word for 'Great Treasure', the rolling hills of the Awarere Valley and river terraces make up the rugged backdrop to our Kuranui vineyard. The interconnectivity between the landscape, soils and climate, create the optimal conditions for growing the Sauvignon Blanc grape vines. Kuranui celebrates this harmony between the elements, echoed by the ribbons found on the front of the label.
