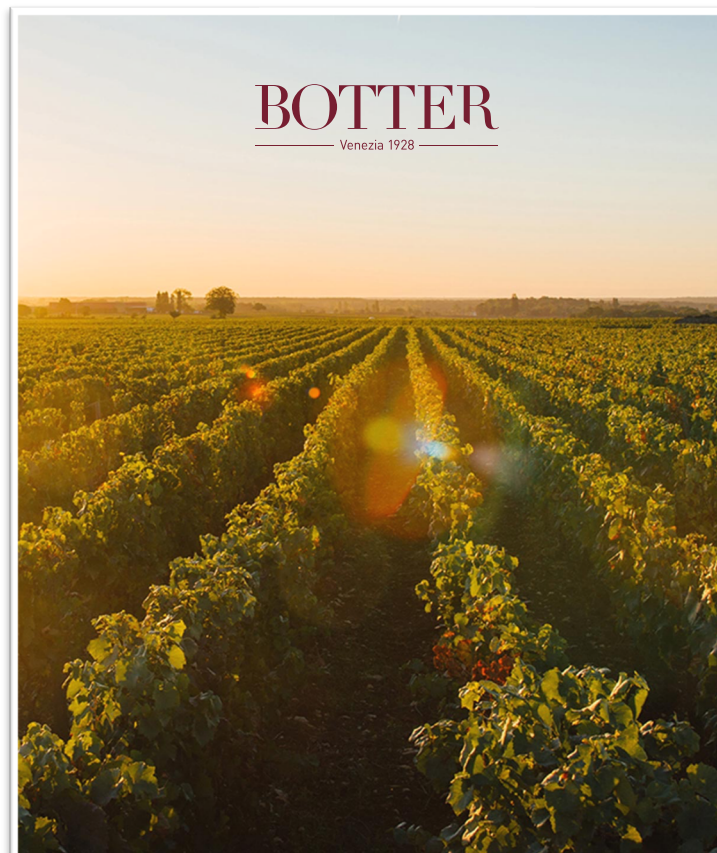

Gran Villarini, a premium range under the highly popular Villarini umbrella, has been developed in close cooperation between ViniMundi and Casa Botter. The Botter family is based in the Veneto region, between Venice and Verona, and the home of Valpolicella and Amarone. This is also the heritage that is the soul of Gran Villarini, whether the vineyards are situated in sunny Puglia, or the cooler

Veneto region. Luca, Annalisa and Alessandro Botter, who represent the third generation of the family, are now integrating their almost centenary traditions with a vision focused on future and innovation. A large part of the Mediterranean island is characterized by volcanic soil and warm, dry climate. The grapes for Villarini come from selected family owned vineyards in western Sicily, where climate and tradition give perfect conditions to produce interesting wines with depth and character.



Grillo 2025

The grapes for Villarini Grillo are soft pressed and the must obtained ferments for 15/20 days at a controlled temperature, 17-18 °C (62-64 °F), in stainless steel tanks. The wine is then stored at 18-20 °C (64/68 °F) in steel tanks until the bottling time. Displays aromas of ripe melon with hints of gooseberry, rounded off with fresh mint. Yellow fruit aromas of apricot and mango balanced with invigorating citrus notes.



Nero d'Avola 2025

40% of this wine is aged for 10 months in first and second passage oak barrels ("barriques", 60% French / 40% of American oak).

90 Points – '24 James Suckling – *"Hazelnuts, chocolate and cherry jam on the nose, followed by a ripe, juicy and medium- to full-bodied palate with berry-soaked tannins."*



Cabernet Sauvignon 2025

The grapes are harvested by hand, and 40% of this wine is aged for 10 months in first and second passage oak barrels ("barriques", 60% French / 40% of American oak). Displays some of the classic Cabernet Sauvignon aromas of black current, plum, and fresh herbs, but also a spicy character of coffee and dark chocolate.
